If the institution is not a university, it is the responsibility of the applicant to document the equivalency of each content area through submission of supporting materials. Such materials would include curriculum, bibliographies, dates and hours of study, name and qualifications of instructor or sponsoring organization, a certificate of satisfactory completion, and so forth. An official transcript must be sent to the ABE from each college or university where you received education in the content area. Documentation must also be attached from the Institute or Agency where you received the content area.
